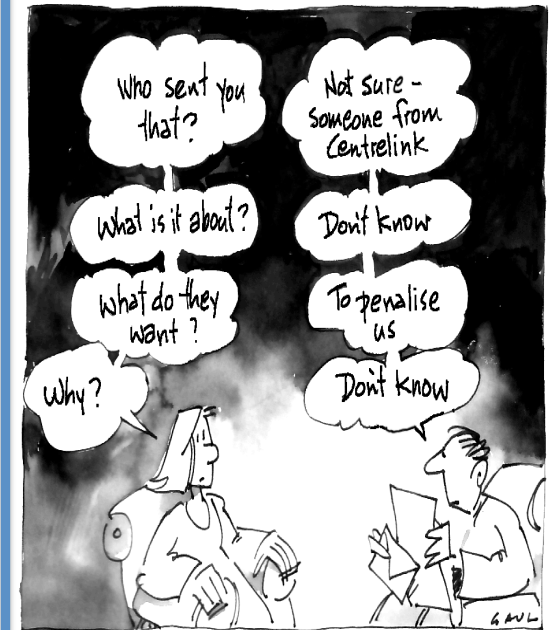

- ◆ Ask Centrelink for a copy of your file so you know what information they used to make a decision.
- ◆ Ask Centrelink to review decisions.
- ◆ Work on campaigns for law reform.
- ◆ We may assist you with your matter at the Social Security Appeals Tribunal (SSAT) or Administrative Appeals Tribunal (AAT).
- ◆ We are part of the National Welfare Rights Network.
